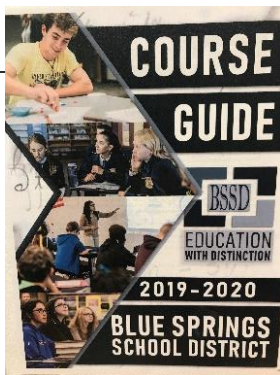


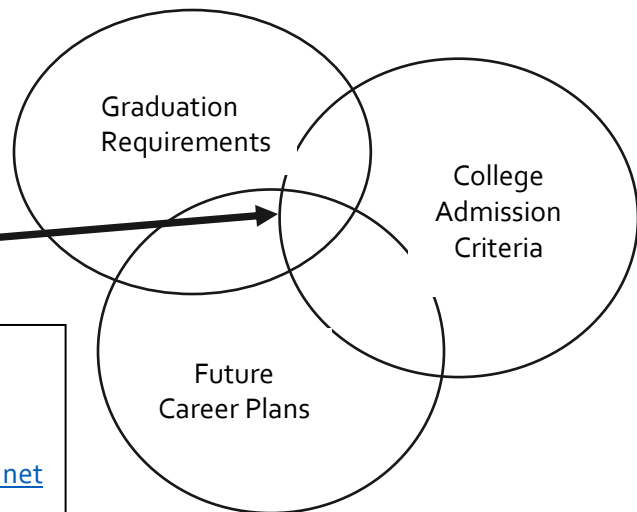
# LET'S GET ENROLLED!

## NAVIGATING THROUGH YOUR ENROLLMENT/ICAP FORM

CHECKLIST (MUST COMPLETE)	TIPS FOR ENROLLMENT
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Review your form. See your counselor if an error is found.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> To figure out what you still need to complete for graduation, look at the "Graduation Progress" link on your Parent/Student Portal page.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Fill out your plan for the rest of high school. Enrollment only occurs for the upcoming year.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> The graduation requirements are on page 4 of the course guide. Use website below: <a href="http://highschoolcourseguide.com">http://highschoolcourseguide.com</a></li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Complete A-P on the enrollment sheet, carefully evaluating each section.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> List your alternate classes in rank order. Make sure the alternates you've listed you are actually ok with taking.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Get initials from your core teachers, indicating approval of next year's course selection.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Get parent signature</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Have it all filled out and complete by February 4<sup>th</sup>. You will meet individually with your counselor through your social studies class.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Utilize summer school – taking Personal Finance is a great way to get ahead before your senior year.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Register for the ACT. Take it over the summer.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Research your plans after high school. Find out what classes your top college picks require for admission. Make a plan to put these classes in your schedule.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Take classes that align with your future plans. Use the course description book online to help choose the best classes to serve your future plans.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> If you do not plan to be a full-time student, whether for BSSD programs, CTC, or 8<sup>th</sup> semester release, make sure that you can still fit in all your graduation requirements.             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> There are applications with these programs, see your counselor for this information.</li> </ul> </li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> If you intend to compete at the collegiate level, register on the Eligibility Center and take at least 16 core classes throughout high school. <a href="http://www.eligibilitycenter.org">www.eligibilitycenter.org</a></li> </ul>
